The University Mace

Symbols of authority and power, maces were originally hand weapons for use against armor. Traditionally carried in processions at formal academic events, they evoke the history and ideals of the institutions they represent. The staff of the University of Massachusetts Boston mace is fluted mahogany; its foot is brass. At its top, in a mahogany surround on a blue granite base, stands a bronze disk bearing the campus seal, consisting of a lighthouse radiating beams of light, with ocean waves below, with the statement "to preserve and extend knowledge." Reflecting the incorporation of Boston State College into the university in 1982, the bronze sides of the seal's base bear the names and dates of that college and its five predecessor institutions, the first of which was founded in 1852.

Academic Costume and Regalia

The academic regalia worn by faculty and students at this ceremony represent traditions that come down from the Middle Ages, when European universities were institutions of the church. At that time, robes were a common form of dress, particularly for officials of church and state. The cut of the robe, its adornment, and the colors used comprised a specialized heraldry that conveyed the rank and station of the wearer. At the universities, both faculty and students were considered to be part of the church hierarchy and were expected to wear the prescribed gowns. As society moved toward more modern forms of dress, only royalty, clergy, judges, and academics retained the traditional regalia, reserving it only for ceremonial use.

Modern academic regalia retain some of the symbols of the earlier forms of ceremonial dress. The gown tends to be fullest, longest, and heaviest for the doctoral degree. The sleeves for the bachelor's and master's gowns are typically open at the wrist. Cuffs are more common on the doctoral gown, and its sleeves are adorned by three velvet strips, symbolic of the degree. The mantle worn about the shoulders, called the hood, is the remnant of functional headgear worn for warmth in the unheated classrooms of medieval universities.

The usual color for academic gowns in the United States is black. However, many universities in this country and many others throughout the world have adopted more colorful robes. In general, this practice has been limited to schools more than one hundred years old. Among the schools represented by colorful robes at commencement ceremonies are Boston College, Boston University, Brown, Columbia, Cornell, Dartmouth, Duke, Harvard, New York, Oxford, Princeton, Rutgers, Stanford, Tufts, and Yale Universities, and the Universities of California, Kansas, and Rhode Island.

Honorary Degrees For centuries, universities have awarded honorary degrees as a way of recognizing extraordinary achievement and affirming institutional values. Our own university's policy is typical: the recipients of honorary degrees "shall be persons of great accomplishment and high ethical standards who exemplify the ideals of the University of Massachusetts"; recipients may not, however, hold federal or state elective office in Massachusetts.

Chancellor's Medal

Attorney General Andrea Joy Campbell Chancellor's Medal for Distinguished Service



The Honorable Andrea Joy Campbell was sworn in on January 18, 2023, as the 45th attorney general of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and the first Black woman to hold the position. Her dedication to economic opportunity, children's mental health, breaking cycles of incarceration, and ensuring equal access to the Office of the Attorney General drives her efforts to create a fairer, more inclusive Massachusetts.

Since taking office, Attorney General Campbell has focused on the issues she believes are most critical, including economic stability, the fight against wage theft, reducing the cycle of incarceration, and challenging discriminatory practices to ensure equal access to opportunities for all. Under her leadership, the Office of the Attorney General is tackling behavioral health challenges to prevent school dropout, crime, substance abuse, and economic hardship. She has introduced initiatives to reduce incarceration, including decriminalizing minor offenses, reforming pretrial detention, and improving reentry services to prevent reoffending. Additionally, she has made her office more accessible by establishing units to protect older residents from fraud, uphold gun laws, and safeguard reproductive rights.

Before becoming attorney general, Campbell was the first woman to represent District 4 on the Boston City Council, where she passed the Community Preservation Act and secured funding for youth development. In 2018, she became the first Black woman elected City Council president. Prior to that, she served as legal counsel to Governor Deval Patrick and general counsel at the Metropolitan Area Planning Council, focusing on education, transportation, and climate issues. She also practiced employment law at Proskauer Rose LLP and advocated for children's rights with the EdLaw Project.

Raised in Roxbury, Campbell overcame adversity, turning struggle into opportunity. A Boston Latin School graduate, she went on to Princeton and UCLA Law, always staying true to her roots. Her unshakable spirit and advocacy for overlooked communities make her not only a public servant, but a powerful role model and driving force for a more just future.

For her ongoing commitment to serving the people of Massachusetts and creating a more inclusive community, the University of Massachusetts Boston is proud to present Attorney General Andrea Joy Campbell with the Chancellor's Medal for Distinguished Service.

Chancellor's Medal

Governor Janet T. Mills '70 Chancellor's Medal for Distinguished Service



Janet Trafton Mills was sworn in on January 2, 2019, as the 75th governor of Maine and the first woman to serve in the role. Under her leadership, Maine's gross domestic product has seen the strongest growth in New England and has outpaced larger states like California, New York, and Virginia. In just four years, Maine's economic growth has surpassed that of the previous fifteen years.

To achieve this, Governor Mills has focused on workforce development, infrastructure enhancements, and maintaining fiscal discipline. By investing in education, job training, child care, housing, health care, and broadband through her Maine Jobs & Recovery Plan, she addressed long-standing workforce shortages and laid the groundwork for a more resilient and future-ready economy.

In other efforts to drive sustainable growth, Governor Mills led the creation of Maine's first comprehensive economic development plan in over a decade. She directed more than \$344 million in tax relief to residents and small businesses, providing vital financial support across the state. Guided by input from over 1,300 residents, she implemented strategic investments and policies that have propelled Maine's economic growth and resilience. Her prudent fiscal policies have also expanded the state's reserve fund to more than \$900 million.

Before becoming governor, Mills was the first and only woman to serve as Maine's attorney general, holding the position from 2009 to 2011 and again from 2013 to 2019. She followed in the footsteps of her father, who served as U.S. attorney for the District of Maine under Presidents Eisenhower and Nixon. A proud native of Farmington, Maine, she made it her mission to protect the people of Maine and fight for their rights, ensuring they had access to the resources and protections they needed to thrive. She took on dishonest mortgage lenders to help families stay in their homes and held Big Pharma accountable for its role in the opioid crisis. By reinvesting opioid settlement funds, she provided overdose-reversal kits that have saved more than 1,000 lives and worked to protect health care coverage for young adults across Maine.

An alumna of the University of Massachusetts Boston and a graduate of the University of Maine School of Law, Mills has dedicated her career to public service. It is with great pride that we present Governor Janet T. Mills with the Chancellor's Medal for Distinguished Service.

Chancellor's Medal

Representative Michael J. Moran '96 Chancellor's Medal for Distinguished Service



Since 2005, Michael J. Moran has represented the 18th Suffolk District, which includes parts of Brighton, Allston, Brookline, and Cambridge. Throughout his tenure, he has played key roles in shaping legislative priorities and strategy, serving in several leadership positions in the Massachusetts House of Representatives, including assistant majority leader, chair of the Joint Committee on Election Laws, and since 2023, majority leader.

Having grown up in a family that faced the challenges of immigration, Moran has led efforts to expand equity, uplift underserved communities, and ensure all residents have access to opportunity, essential services, and fair representation regardless of their background. He helped Charles River Community Health secure land for a Brighton facility now serving over 15,500 patients annually, mostly immigrants. His efforts to create stronger political representation for these communities by redrawing district lines resulted in the creation of the most diverse congressional district in Massachusetts and increased representation for immigrant and minority communities in the State House.

By sponsoring an act that established a bill of rights for domestic workers, Moran demonstrated his commitment to protecting vulnerable workers. A transformative piece of legislation, the 2014 law is the most extensive in the nation, ensuring fair treatment and improved working conditions while safeguarding domestic workers against abuse, harassment, and discrimination.

A strong advocate for voter reform, he has been a driving force behind legislation aimed at expanding voter access by leading efforts to allow early voting, simplify absentee voting, and ensure military personnel and overseas voters can cast their ballots. He also advocated for the preregistration of young voters and supported measures to make voting by mail a permanent option, all of which have helped improve voter engagement and turnout across the state.

A lifelong resident of Brighton, he proudly represents the community where he grew up, with a deep understanding of its needs and dynamics. The University of Massachusetts Boston is honored to call him a distinguished alumnus, having earned his degree in economics in 1996. In recognition of his commitment to improving the lives of his constituents and advocating for positive change across the state, we are proud to present Representative Michael J. Moran with the Chancellor's Medal for Distinguished Service.

Honorary Degree Recipients

Cathleen Douglas Stone Doctor of Humane Letters



Cathleen Douglas Stone is president of the James M. and Cathleen D. Stone Foundation, which is dedicated to promoting a more knowledgeable and inclusive society, with emphasis on fostering environmental sustainability and mitigating wealth inequality. Previously, she was of counsel and a past partner of the law firm Foley, Hoag & Eliot. Appointed Boston's first chief of environmental services in 1994, Stone helped launch the Sustainable Boston initiative and helped create the Boston Harbor Islands National Park.

She currently serves on the Board of Directors of Boston Harbor Now and The Wilderness Society, and she is on the Museum of African American History (MAAH) Stone Book Award Honorary Committee. She served more than 25 years on the Boston Water and Sewer Commission; was chair of the Museum of African American History Board of Directors; and served on the Board of Directors of The Nature Conservancy, National Public Radio, the Supreme Court Historical Society, WBUR Boston, and Match Charter Public High School.

In 2006, Stone received the Eleanor Roosevelt Following In Her Footsteps Award, and in 2017, she received the Norman B. Leventhal Excellence in City Building Award. She earned her BA and JD from American University and an LLM from Georgetown University Law Center.

For her continuing commitment to environmental sustainability and the promotion of equality, the University of Massachusetts Boston is pleased to award Cathleen Douglas Stone the honorary doctorate of humane letters.

Martin J. Walsh Doctor of Humane Letters



The Honorable Martin J. Walsh has long been an advocate for working people, equity, and community empowerment. From his early days as a union laborer to leading the Building and Construction Trades Council, serving two terms as mayor of Boston, and later as U.S. secretary of labor, he has championed fair wages, safer workplaces, and workers' rights. Known for his pragmatic, community-first leadership, Walsh now brings these same values to his role as executive director of the National Hockey League Players' Association.

A proud Dorchester native, Walsh attended The Newman School before graduating from Boston College. As mayor of Boston, he helped generate 140,000 jobs, attracted major employers, and expanded affordable housing. He focused on closing the racial wealth gap, addressed veterans' homelessness, and revitalized the Mayor's Office for Immigrant Advancement. He expanded universal pre-K, introduced free community college programs, and established the nation's first municipal Office of Recovery Services. During the pandemic, Walsh swiftly transformed the Boston Convention and Exhibition Center into a 1,000-bed field hospital to ease the burden on health care facilities.

As U.S. secretary of labor, Walsh prioritized workers' rights nationally. He launched the Good Jobs Initiative to expand employment opportunities and apprenticeship programs. He advanced key policy reforms and finalized rules enforcing protections against surprise medical billing.

In recognition of his lifelong dedication to improving communities across the nation, promoting equity, and giving people a voice, the University of Massachusetts Boston is proud to confer upon Martin J. Walsh an honorary doctorate of humane letters.

2025 Distinguished Faculty Awards

Professor Elora Chowdhury, Department of Women's, Gender, and Sexuality Studies

Chancellor's Award for Distinguished Scholarship



Professor Elora Chowdhury is widely recognized as an intellectual leader both on campus and in the fields of transnational women's studies, South Asian Studies, and critical development studies. Her work over the past two decades has offered sophisticated ways of understanding and advancing innovative approaches to development that are grounded in transnational feminist practice and Bangladeshi history, culture, and society. Her career-long contributions richly convey the mission and values of the university and align with our Grand Scholarly Challenges, particularly Advancing a Just Society, Climate Equity, and Education for the Future. She has authored two acclaimed monographs—*Ethical Encounters:* Transnational Feminism, Human Rights, and War Cinema in Bangladesh (2022) and Transnationalism Reversed: Women Organizing Against Gendered Violence in Bangladesh (2011). Additionally, she has co-edited 3 interdisciplinary books, along with 26 journal articles, and 18 book chapters that integrate transnational feminist studies and development studies with film/culture/narrative studies and human rights. Professor Chowdhury's high level of productivity, her international reputation and receipt of major awards in her fields, and her scholarly leadership at UMass Boston through initiatives like her Ford Foundation collaborative grant on Islamic feminisms all constitute a compelling case for her to be recognized with our university's highest scholarly honor in 2025.

Professor Juanita Urban-Rich, School for the Environment Chancellor's Award for Distinguished Teaching



Professor Juanita Urban-Rich's teaching, advising, and mentoring is of such enduring quality and effect that it merits recognition as distinguished. She has developed and delivered K-12 curricula to undergraduates and PhD students alike. In addition to her classroom teaching, she has dedicated countless hours to mentoring dozens of undergraduate and graduate students in her lab. Anyone who has passed through the second-floor lab space in UMass Boston's Integrated Sciences Complex during the past few years likely caught a glimpse of Professor Urban-Rich's passionate instruction and guidance. Her role as a highly regarded researcher has made her a sought-after mentor in scientific research across the university. That mentor-protégé relationship has paid dividends in the form of published research, successful degree completion, and career advancement among her students. Professor Urban-Rich's role as the School for the Environment's graduate program director also points to her important contributions in ensuring that all our graduate students benefit from rigorous, relevant education and training. Excellent teachers don't limit their instruction to the classroom. They integrate teaching into every facet of their work. Students who are fortunate enough to engage with Professor Urban-Rich come away from their experience at UMass Boston with a keener understanding of the fields in which they've worked and studied. The very fortunate come away with an enhanced understanding that learning is a lifelong process to sustain their intellectual curiosity and continued learning. Professor Urban-Rich's students, research assistants, protégés, and colleagues are very, very fortunate that she devotes so much energy to teaching and guiding our undergraduate and graduate students.

Professor Zong-Guo Xia, School for the Environment Chancellor's Award for Distinguished Service



Professor Zong-Guo Xia has compiled an impressive record of service that spans two decades at UMass Boston and extends across multiple departments and units. Professor Xia has been one of the most dedicated, resourceful, and impactful leaders on our campus. His career of research productivity, program development, and administrative leadership has inspired and advanced many at UMass Boston. Professor Xia's areas of expertise and scholarly contributions reflect his pioneering work across the fields of geographic information sciences (GIS) with special expertise in remote sensing and interdisciplinary applications of analytical cartography to environmental management and policy analysis. He established the geographic information sciences graduate program, which quickly became one of UMass Boston's signature units of research and training in service to the region and one of the best GIS teaching and research facilities in the country. Among his many roles, Professor Xia provided pivotal leadership as vice provost for research and graduate studies. He also led a university committee charged with planning and establishing the School of Global Inclusion and Social Development (SGISD). His critical contribution to establishing SGISD was modeled across the university as he worked to enhance the entire research infrastructure and expand the opportunity pathways for graduate education at UMass Boston. Professor Xia recently completed a term as elected chair of the university's Faculty Council from AY22 through AY24. In effectively positioning the faculty as a key leader in shared governance from the COVID pandemic period through the appointment of a new chancellor and the development of UMass Boston's strategic plan, For the Times, Professor Xia's grounded, principled, and data-informed leadership was highly influential and greatly appreciated.
